

Are you afraid to weave with linen? In this workshop, you'll discover that linen is a wonderful, user-friendly fiber and learn the best techniques for warping, weaving, and finishing linen fabrics. Participants will thread four- or eight-shaft looms in various sizes of linen yarns and in round robin fashion, explore Huck lace, Bronson lace, Swedish lace, and various hand-manipulated laces.

Suzie Liles has taught weaving for 30 years. Suzie is very enthusiastic and loves to share her knowledge. She has taught workshops and seminars for adults and children in the United States and Canada. Liles completed a B.F.A. in Fibers (2004) and an M.F.A. in Fibers (2006) at the University of Oregon.
