More details and answers to frequently wondered questions

- Viña de Lestonnac Retreat Center is centrally located in the beautiful Temecula Valley Wine Country. It offers a relaxing atmosphere featuring exceptional locally grown food and breathtaking views. Check out their website. https://www.lestonnacretreatcenters.com/vina
- Lodging and 3 meals/day are included in the retreat pricing. Rooms are clean and simple, each with 2 twin beds and an ensuite bathroom. Rates are based on double occupancy, so bring a friend! You can have the room to yourself for a small supplement. Some rooms are up a short flight of stairs; there is no elevator. We'll help with your suitcase, don't worry. Special diet needs are joyfully accommodated; snacks and additional beverages are BYO and allowed. No smoking is permitted.
- The studio space is a large meeting room, with plenty of space for us all. It is safe and secure, and exclusive to our group. We will set up our looms on Monday, and have them in place through Thursday. We will then transition to our sewing machines on provided tables on Friday. If you live too far to bring your loom, let Suzanne know you need to borrow one. She'll also help arrange to borrow a sewing machine. If you don't yet have a SAORI loom now would be a great time to order one and pick it up at the Retreat! How fun is that?!
- Warps so many options! 1) bring your warp,2) chose a warp on Monday, 3) discuss with Suzanne ahead of time, and pick up your custom warp on Monday, or 4) whatever else you want to do that I haven't thought of. Which brings up the topic of...
- Weft material and other fiber fun bring some! Or buy a kit. Or use what I bring and we'll weigh it. Or whatever works for you. This is a joyful weaving retreat. No rules, no required set ups or pre-Retreat homework.
- After dinner, Evenings can be spent weaving, making art yarn, chit chatting, knitting sleeves
 to add to a woven garment (you knew I'd get that in!), getting inspired by others' work,
 simply hangin' out in the studio, perhaps with an adult beverage, or resting in your room. I
 have special plans for a couple of the evenings surprises.
- Garment making will be awesome. You can use the cloth you just wove, or other creatively woven cloth that you bring with you. If this is not your first rodeo, i.e. you've been to a SAORI garment making workshop before, you can choose what to make and get help and guidance as/if needed. If this is your 1st opportunity to construct with creatively handwoven cloth, you can follow along as we all make a Sleeveless Duster/Casual Coat (Jacket) together.
- The Fashion Show will also be awesome! For those that were at The SAORI Experience in 2022, you know it is not a typical fashion show, as we may not all be typical models. But it is kinda fun to see everyone wearing her handwoven, hand constructed and sewn, fabulous, unique wearable! So be ready to join the fun, and I may even treat to mimosas. It is brunch, after all.
- And finally, *Special requests* are always considered. Want to join but can't make the whole week? Live really close by and prefer to "commute"? Want to arrive Sunday night prior and need a recommendation of where to stay? Need a ride from SAN airport? Just ask.
