TWINING A FABRIC PLACEMAT

with Vicki France

Learn the art of twining while making a placemat using
fabric strips and a frame loom.

WEDNESDAYS, MARCH 18 & 25, 2026



Location: Central Tucson

Instructions will be provided to make your own 16" X 20" frame loom to bring with you,
or you can purchase one from Vicki for \$20 that you can keep.

Warping materials will be provided at no charge.

Bring fabric cut or torn into 2" wide strips. Cotton or poly-cotton are best choices. Consider up-cycling old sheets or curtains. Choose 2 contrasting colors – dark and light or print and solid.

You will need a total length of about 1600" (45 yds) of strips.

Example: If fabric is 54" X 36", you will get 18 horizontal 2" strips that are 54" long (18 X 54" = 972").

In this example, if you had another piece of fabric in a contrasting color of the same size,
you would have 972" X 2 = 1944", which would be more than enough to complete your mat.
